## Anomatic Completes Sustainability Initiatives

Anomatic Corp. (Newark, OH), a specialist in high-volume anodized components, announced completion of a sustainability plan, which it began in early 2008. The plan was designed to reduce energy use, waste, water, and air pollution, while significantly increasing the supplier's ability to recycle and reuse materials. Landmark achievements include:

- Up to 40% of process water is recycled and reused via advanced recycling technologies.
- A new closed-cycle vapor-technology cleaning system will be installed in September, which will reduce 92% of carbon-based energy for cleaning of raw parts prior to anodizing. It will also recover 80 to 90% of stamping oil for reuse.
- A waste-water treatment system was upgraded to a PLC logic-based control system, which will lower chemical usage by improving operations and automated controls.
- Current air scrubber technology removes more than 98% of nitrogen oxides, operating at less than 40% of EPA permits.
